School Milk

The cost of school milk for the second half of the Spring Term and the Summer Term 2017 (28 February 2017 to 21 July 2017) will be £14.79. Please note, that the milk supplied is semi-skimmed.

Please could you indicate whether your child requires milk for this period. Please complete the slip at the foot of this letter and return it, to school, with your payment, by not later than **Monday, 13 February 2017**.

Cheques should be made payable to 'Sheffield City Council'.

The administration of milk is very time consuming and we would, therefore, appreciate your cooperation. This system will enable us to order the correct amount of milk from the dairy before the half term break and ensure that all classes have up to date lists in time for the first day of term. This should also alleviate difficulties caused when children believe they are having milk, but for whom none has been ordered.

Please note, if your child is under the age of 5, they are eligible for **free** milk. We will inform you on, or around, your child's 5th birthday when payment is due.

If your child is entitled to income related free school meals, they are also entitled to free milk. However this will **not** be ordered unless you complete and return the slip attached.
