### **Competition Rules**

**SUMMER IS...** This is a photographic competition open to children and their families who attend Hunters Bar Infant school depicting what the season Summer means to you.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that they have read and abided by the Rules and the submission guidelines.

- 1a) There are 3 categories for photographs taken by children who attend Hunters Bar Infant School:
  - i. Reception children
  - ii. Year 1 children
  - iii. Year 2 children
- 1b)There are 3 categories for photographs taken by **parents**, **carers or grandparents** (NOT SIBLINGS) of children who attend Hunters Bar Infant School:
  - i. Reception family adults
  - ii. Year 1 family adults
  - iii. Year 2 family adults

NB where more than one child from a family attends HBI, a photo may be submitted by a **different** family adult for each child. For example-Child A + parent/grandparent A photo entries and Child B + another parent/grandparent B photo entries

### **Competition Rules**

**SUMMER IS...** This is a photographic competition open to children and their families who attend Hunters Bar Infant school depicting what the season Summer means to you.

It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that they have read and abided by the Rules and the submission guidelines.

- 2a) Photograph entries should clearly state who has taken the image also where and when the image was taken. Photographs must not include images of identifiable children or adults.
- b) Images must be of the United Kingdom of Great Britain & Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands.
- c) Images may be black and white or colour and must have been taken by the child or adult submitting the photograph entry.
- d) Images must have been taken within the year immediately prior to the closing date.
- e) Images that have won an award in a major competition, or that have been entered in such a competition where the results are pending, are not eligible for entry.
- f) Once entered into the Competition, identical images must not be entered into any major competition whose results are announced prior to 12.7.21 until the entrant is informed by HBI that the image has not reached the next stage of judging.
- g) On Monday 12th July 2021 the winners of each category will be notified. The judge's decision is final.
