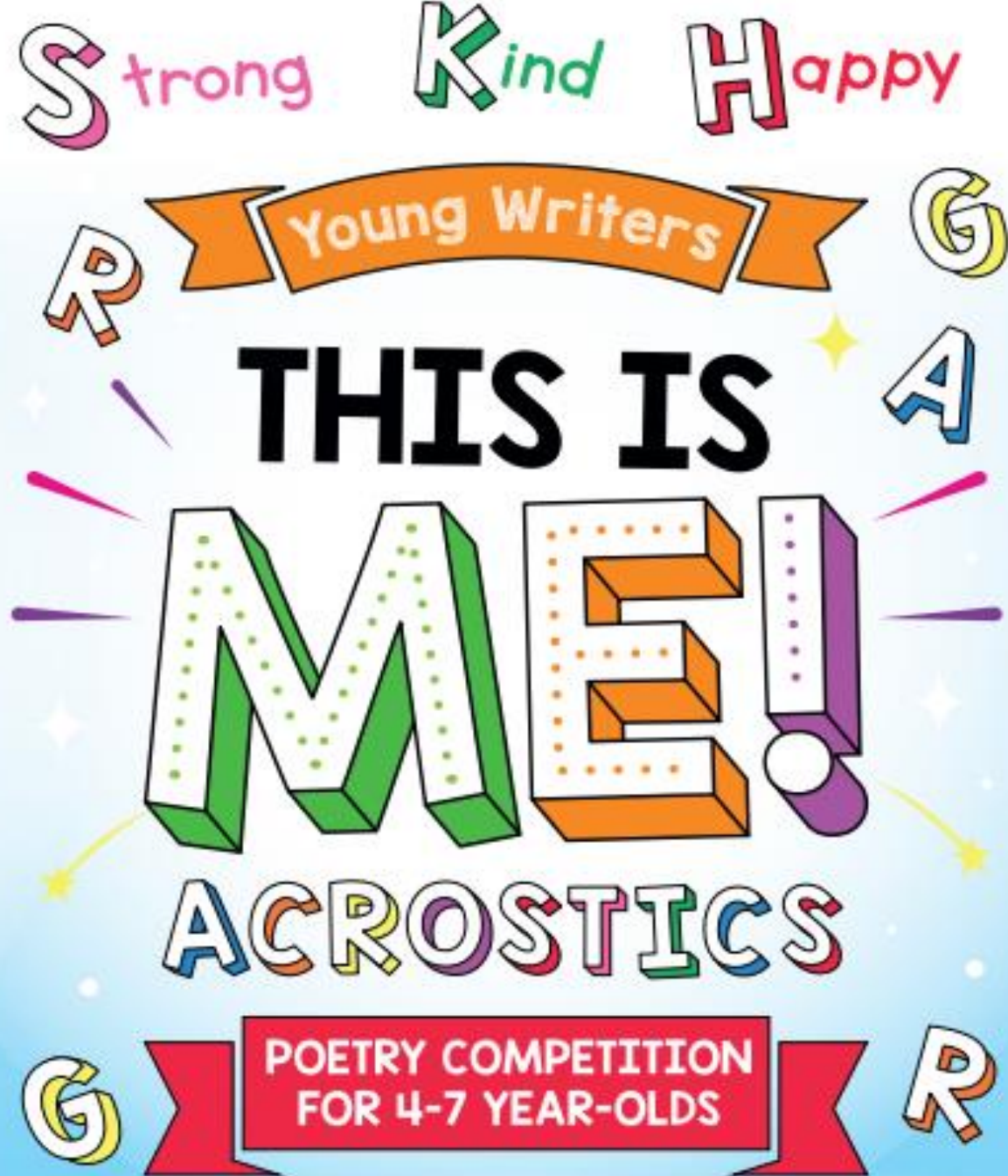

Fun

Smart

intelligent, or able to think quickly OR having a clean, tidy, and stylish appearance

Awesome

extremely good

Messy

producing or causing dirt and untidiness

Brave

not frightened of danger

Passionate

having very strong feelings or emotions about something or someone

Silly

not important, serious, or practical

Angry

feeling or showing strong annoyance, displeasure, or hostility

Lonely

unhappy because you are not with other people

Curious

interested in learning about people or things around you

Friendly

behaving in a pleasant, kind way towards someone
