

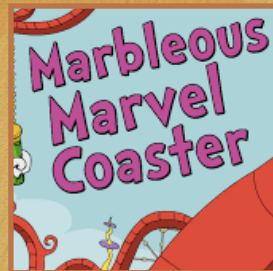
### Overview

A simulation is computer software that lets you 'pretend' to try out something that would be too dangerous, difficult or expensive to try in real life.

A simulation can let you test 'what happens if I ...' situations without risk. They can show what happens next or what happened in the past.
