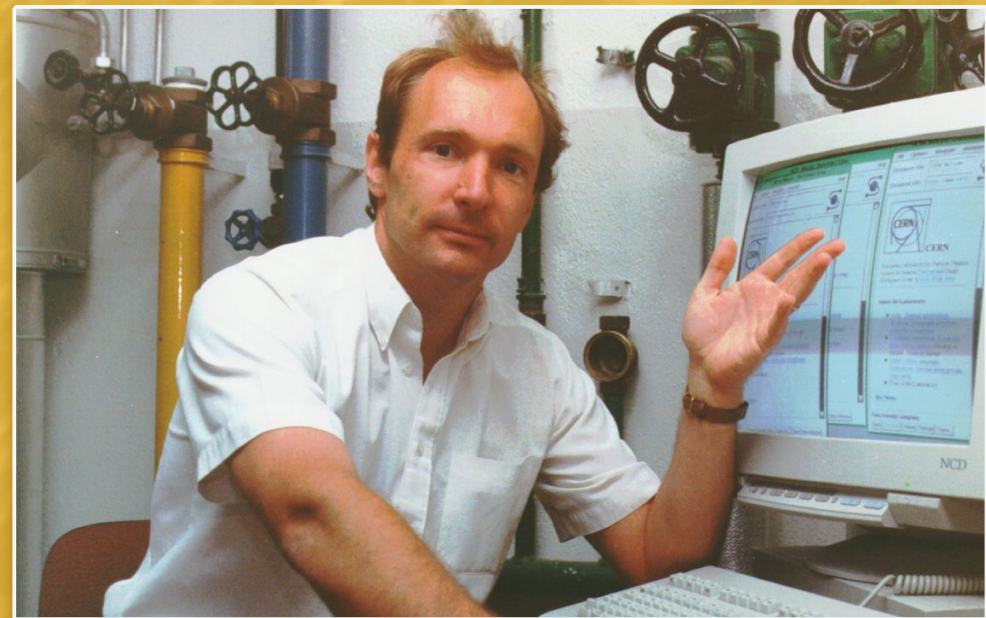
Sir Tim Bernes-Lee was born in London.

He's a computer scientist, best known for his invention of the World Wide Web. This initially started when Tim was working at a science laboratory in Switzerland. He was interested in finding a way to help scientists share experiments with each other.

He launched his first website in 1999, describing it as the 'World Wide Web.'

He also created the first web browser used to search for web pages.

His work as a famous computer scientist led him to being awarded a knighthood by Queen Elizabeth II in 2004.



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
