star

Stars are huge, glowing balls of gases. The closest star to Earth is the Sun. Most of the pinpricks of light that shine in the night sky are also stars. Most stars are incredibly far away. Stars vary in size, temperature, brightness, and color. A star's temperature, as well as its chemicals, makes it shine in a certain color. The bluer stars are usually hotter, while the redder stars are cooler. The Sun is somewhere in between.
